Details on Scholarships Offered & Submission Requirements

Tuition Scholarship

- This scholarship is to be utilized for tuition, books, or fees associated with undergraduate or graduate school attendance.
- The value of the scholarship is *up to* \$1000.
- Undergraduate and graduate students are eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- Suggested timeframe: 8 weeks prior to the start of the term
- Students should submit the following:
 - 1. CV
 - 2. One professional or academic recommendation letter
 - 3. Most Recent Transcript
 - 4. Essay of approximately 600 words about your future career goals related to Hydrography.

Internship / Research

- This scholarship is to be utilized by the student to participate in an internship/fellowship.
- The value of the scholarship is *up to* \$2000.
- Undergraduate and graduate students are eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- Suggested timeframe: 8 weeks prior to the anticipated start of the internship.
- Students should submit the following:
 - 1. CV
 - 2. One professional or academic recommendation letter
 - 3. Transcript
 - 4. Essay of approximately 600 words demonstrating how the internship will assist the student in pursuing a career in a field related to Hydrography.
 - 5. Budget showing the direct costs related to the internship and documentation justifying the costs (e.g. flight receipt, room & board costs, etc).

<u>Certification / Training</u>

- This scholarship is to be used by the student to receive a professional certification or attend a professional training (e.g., BOSIET, Captain's License, micro-credentials etc.).
- The value of the scholarship is *up to* \$1000.
- Undergraduate and graduate students are eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- Suggested timeframe: 8 weeks prior to the start of the course or training.
- Students should submit the following:
 - 1. CV
 - 2. One professional or academic recommendation letter
 - 3. Transcript
 - 4. Essay approximately 600 words justifying the need for the professional certification and demonstrating how the certification will assist the student in pursuing a career in a field related to Hydrography.

5. Budget showing the direct costs related to attending the certification / training and documentation justifying the costs (e.g. flight receipt, room & board costs, etc).

Conference Attendance

- This scholarship is to be used by the student to attend a conference.
- The value of the scholarship is *up to* \$2000.
- This scholarship is available to students for expenses related to attending a conference (e.g., registration, travel and meals).
- The conference must be closely related to Hydrography.
- High school, undergraduate and graduate students are eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- Suggested timeframe: 8 weeks prior to the conference.
- Students should submit the following:
 - 1. CV
 - 2. One professional or academic recommendation letter
 - 3. Transcript
 - 4. Essay approximately 600 words demonstrating how attendance to the conference will assist the student in pursuing a career in a field related to Hydrography.
 - 5. Background information about the conference (e.g., name, location, professional body hosting the conference etc.) if not included in THSOA scholarship offering.
 - 6. Budget showing the direct costs related to attending the conference and documentation justifying the costs (e.g. student registration receipt, travel costs, etc).

Guidelines

- Undergraduate students must be enrolled for at least 12 credit hours and graduate students must be enrolled for at least 6 credit hours.
- The applicant must be a citizen/permanent resident of The United States of America or possess a valid U.S. student visa.
- Applications will be reviewed by THSOA Student Outreach and Scholarship Committee.
- Students are not eligible for a national and a regional THSOA scholarship (e.g., THSOA Southeast Chapter) in the same academic year.
