SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA AND AWARD PROCESS

- ▶ Scholarships are available to full-time (12+ credits/semester), college students who are currently enrolled in an undergraduate (two-year/four-year) or graduate program.
- ▶ The university/program must have accreditation recognized by the U.S. Department of Education, and must be located in one of the New England states: Connecticut, Rhode Island, Massachusetts, Vermont, New Hampshire, and Maine.
- ▶ Applicants must be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States.
- ▶ Students should demonstrate a keen interest in pursuing a career in hydrographic surveying or related fields.
- ▶ For 2024-2025 academic year, awards will be distributed in increments up to \$1000.
- ▶ Scholarships will be awarded in two rounds.
Round 1 applications will be accepted until June 30, 2024, for award August 2024.
Round 2 applications will be accepted until November 15, 2024, for award January 2025.
- ▶ Scholarship recipients will receive an award e-mail, as well as an award letter and check via USPS mail delivery.
- ▶ Selection will be based on a combination of academic performance, written essay, and answers documented in the application process. Community involvement and volunteering, as well as demonstrated financial need will also be considered.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND CHECKLIST

Submit 1 copy of the following:

- A) Completed Application (this form)
- B) Resume
- C) "Bio" (biography) - paragraph introducing yourself and describing you who are in the context of your study/career path.
- D) Essay explaining your career goals and what you are doing to pursue them.
- E) High School or college transcript (unofficial)
- F) *Optional additional information* - letter of recommendation, personal statement etc.
